Week of January 8th

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV) - “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”

Week of January 22nd

Psalms 37:5-6 (NIV) - “Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this: He will make your righteous reward shine like the noonday sun.”

FEBRUARY

Week of February 12th

I Corinthians 2:9 (NIV) - “However, as it is written: “What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived” — the things God has prepared for those who love him —”

Week of February 26th

Week of April 9th

Proverbs 16:9 (NIV) - “In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps.”

Week of May 7th

I John 5:14 (NIV) - “This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us.”

Week of May 21st

I John 5:15 (NIV) - “And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.”

JUNE

Week of June 4th

Week of December 17th

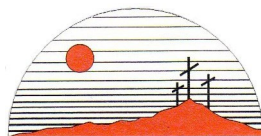
I Peter 4:10 (NIV) - “Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms.”
