⇒ Use the “raise your hand” button to volunteer.

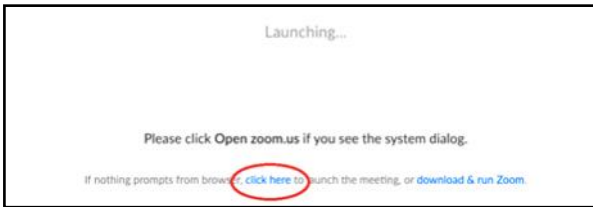
⇒ Use the “clap” or “thumbs up” button to show that you agree or enjoy what you are seeing.

⇒ Use the “chat” to communicate your thoughts and questions.

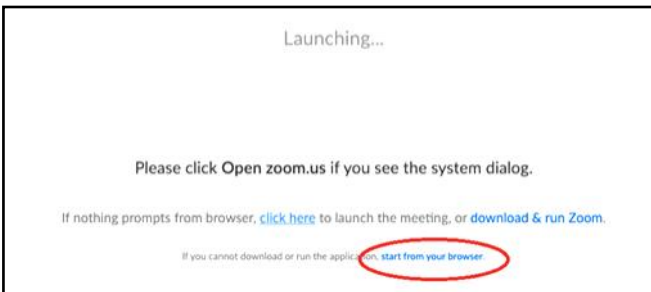
HOW TO ACCESS ZOOM:

Zoom Meetings - Use Chrome

1. In Chrome, copy and paste the zoom link in your web browser.
2. If that does not work, go to zoom.com which redirects you to zoom.us. In the top right, select 'Join a Meeting' and enter in the meeting code and password provided to you by email from the Youth Ministry.
3. If you have Zoom downloaded on your computer, click on 'Open' in Zoom.
4. If the app is not installed on your Mac, you will need to create the meeting from the browser. Wait at this prompt until the option comes up to select 'click here to launch the meeting' and select 'click here' as shown below. ↓



5. On the last prompt, start the zoom session by selecting 'start from your browser.' ↓



The meeting will then start with various meeting controls available to allow you to send out the meeting link and share your screen, toggle video, mic, etc.

~ 1 CORINTHIANS 6:19 & 20 ~

<p>NLT New Living Translation</p>	<p>Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body.</p>
<p>NIV New International Version</p>	<p>Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.</p>
<p>KJV King James Version</p>	<p>What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.</p>
<p>NKJV New King James Version</p>	<p>Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body [a] and in your spirit, which are God's.</p>
<p>GW GOD'S WORD Translation</p>	<p>Don't you know that your body is a temple that belongs to the Holy Spirit? The Holy Spirit, whom you received from God, lives in you. You don't belong to yourselves. You were bought for a price. So bring glory to God in the way you use your body.</p>

SCRIPTURE

~ 1 CORINTHIANS 6:19 & 20 ~

AMP Amplified Bible	Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is within you, whom you have [received as a gift] from God, and that you are not your own [property]? You were bought with a price [you were actually purchased with the precious blood of Jesus and made His own]. So then, honor and glorify God with your body.
ASV American Standard Version	Or know ye not that your body is a [a] temple of the Holy Spirit which is in you, which ye have from God? and ye are not your own; for ye were bought with a price: glorify God therefore in your body.
ERV Easy-to-Read Version	You should know that your body is a temple[a] for the Holy Spirit that you received from God and that lives in you. You don't own yourselves. God paid a very high price to make you his. So honor God with your body.
ESV English Standard Version	Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

ARE YOU SAVED?

Romans 3:23(NIV)

“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

We all have sin in our hearts. We all were born with sin. We were born under the power of sin's control.

- *Admit that you are a sinner.*

Romans 6:23a(NIV)

"...The wages of sin is death..."

Sin has an ending, it results in death. We all face physical death, which is a result of sin. But a worse death is spiritual death that alienates us from God, and will last for all eternity. The Bible teaches that there is a place called the Lake of Fire where lost people will be in torment forever. It is the place where people who are spiritually dead will remain.

- *Understand that you deserve death for your sin.*

Romans 6:23b(NIV)

"...But the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

Salvation is a free gift from God to you! You can't earn this gift, but you must reach out and receive it.

- *Ask God to forgive you and save you.*
